

Exposed Aggregate

Exposed aggregate concrete is a form of decorative **concrete** achieved by removing the top layer of cement paste and revealing the underlying **aggregate**. The decorative **aggregate** now becomes a very durable, skid-resistant surface that is great for sidewalks, driveways, pool decks, and patios.

Aggregate Sizes and Colours

Aggregates of various sizes and colours can be used while executing. A combination of various natural aggregate colours, demarcating areas through various natural aggregate colours, blending, etc can be achieved.

Typically, for a driveway a aggregate size of min 6-8 mm is recommended. For a walkaway, a aggregate size of min 2-4mm is recommended.

Execution Quantity

We can execute large areas of around 2000-3000 sqft per day on an average working for 5 days a week depending on project readiness.

Typical Section Drawing

Option 1

Subbase - Flat Brick Soling (FBS) or Murram

RCC (125mm - 150 mm thick) with **Exposed Aggregate.**

Option 2

Subbase - Flat Brick Soling (FBS) or Murram

PCC (100mm thick)

RCC (75mm - 100 mm thick) with Exposed Aggregate.
